Recruitment blurb

The study seeks to understand the spread of COVID-19 in Jefferson County. The information will be used to keep people healthy and safe during community re-opening. Adults age 18 years and older are invited to participate in the study. The study involves testing with a nasal swab for active infection and finger stick for a recovered infection. If someone tests positive for COVID-19, they will need to follow-up with their healthcare provider and begin isolation. By law, we will be required to report the case to local health agencies. Testing will be done by appointment at UofL Health Northeast, Mary & Elizabeth Hospital and Downtown at Brook and Liberty Streets, and community locations throughout Jefferson County.
