## STUDENT ART CONTEST FEATURING TARC DESIGN-A-BUS

Traditionally, the Student Art Contest is centered around the Derby Festival and its events, but the theme of this year's competition emphasizes a broader message of hope.

Students are asked to reflect on the challenges they've faced in 2020 and the changes in their day-to-day life; choose a word using the prefix "Re" (e.g. Re-imagine, Re-start, Re-build, Re-cover, Re-birth, Re-organize, Re-connect, Re-unite, etc.); and then create an image based on that word. For example: Re-imagine Derby Festival Events, Re-connect with friends, Re-build the community. The goal is that each artwork will showcase the student's resilience in their response to this unprecedented year and a message of optimism for the future.

Please note: The Pegasus is a symbol of the Kentucky Derby Festival.
