



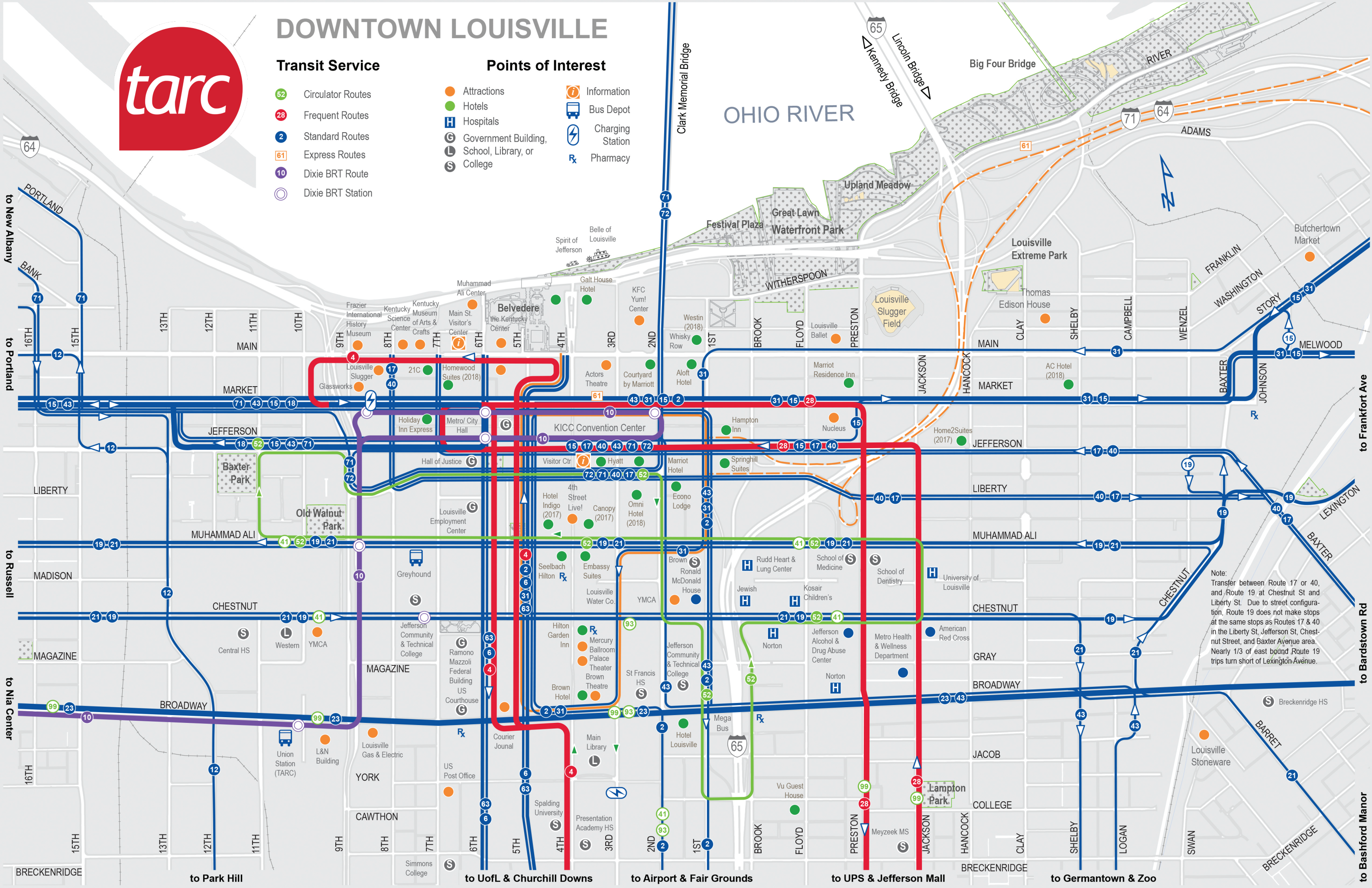

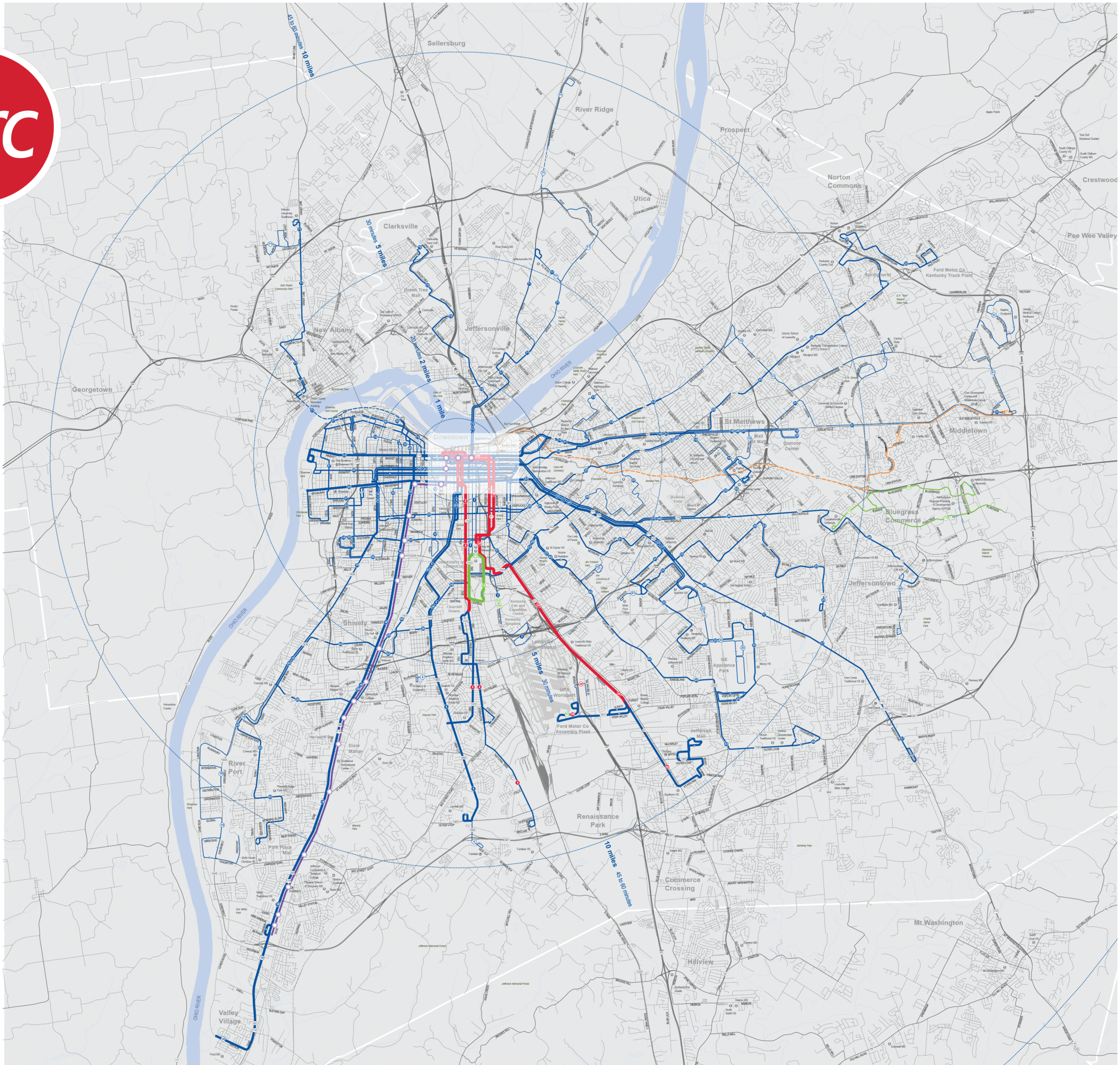

Transfer between Route 17 or 40, and Route 19 at Chestnut St and Liberty St. Due to street configuration, Route 19 does not make stops at the same stops as Routes 17 & 40 in the Liberty St, Jefferson St, Chestnut Street, and Baxter Avenue area. Nearly 1/3 of east bound Route 19 trips turn short of Lexington Avenue.

Solid orange lines indicate where Express Routes operate. The vehicle will not make stops while in closed door service, indicated by a dashed orange line. Streets and bus stops on which Express Routes operate may differ between morning and evening commutes. Express Fare required on all Express Routes.

Bus Rapid Transit Routes

Solid purple lines indicate where Bus Rapid Transit Routes operate. Route 10 is currently Louisville's only BRT line traveling along Dixie HWY into downtown. It features a new Transit Signal Priority system and stops with digital pylons providing real-time communication with Rapid riders.
