Event Summary

TARC 2025 staff made a return visit to Street for People - following up on a May briefing on the TARC 2025 plan - to present the three TARC 2025 concepts and take questions. Key themes of the discussion included:

- Concern over the perceived slow pace of the project
- Recommendations that equity be a key decision-making factor
- Questions around how TARC is engaging marginalized populations in the TARC 2025 process
- Questions about how the network redesign will comply with Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act - the part US Civil Rights law that ensures changes to transit systems do not have a disparate impact on minority and low-income populations
- Questions about how residents can push for more funding for TARC
- Potential steps forward for enhancing local transit revenue
- Concern about the UofL circulator not appearing on any of the conceptual maps
